Our Upcoming Goals

This season, ArtsUp SC is inviting the community to experience storytelling through every artistic lens. Our Storyline Series draws inspiration from Harper Lee's *To Kill a Mockingbird*:

"You never really understand a person until you consider things from his point of view...Until you climb around in his skin and walk around in it."

This season's programming weaves together performances that speak to justice, empathy, identity, and the heart of human connection.

- 1. *Prologue Performance: New Chapters* The opening event in our *Storyline Series* will take place on **August 22, 2025**, at Fernwood Baptist Church. This multi-genre showcase will feature a dynamic lineup of artists from diverse backgrounds, spanning dance, poetry, music, and more. A portion of the proceeds will support the Uplift Outreach Center; an organization committed to providing a safe and affirming space for at-risk LGBTQ+ youth.
- 2. An Evening with Marlanda Dekine will feature powerful poetry performed by poet laureate, social justice advocate, and Hub City Writers author, Marlanda Dekine. Live music and dance will bring her evocative, community-rooted work to life. This immersive event will also feature a community discussion led by Marlanda. The event will take place on Saturday, February 21.
- 3. Pivotal Performance: A Storyline Finale will conclude our 2025/2026 Storyline Series June 2026 (location and date to be announced). This final event will reunite featured artists from prior performances alongside new collaborators. The performance will provide the community with an opportunity to reflect on the season's themes and experiences. Through this dynamic performance, we hope audiences leave with fresh perspectives on art, connection, and the world around them.
